

# What's New in Granicus: June 5, 2015

These release notes are for the June 5, 2015 maintenance releases of MediaManager, Legistar, InSite, SpeakUp and MeetingServer/LiveManager.

*The products related to this release that require a client install are MeetingServer/LiveManager. MediaManager, (Hosted) Legistar, SpeakUp and InSight are all SaaS upgrades and require no action on the user's end.*

## Hosted Updates

Hosted services are automatically updated on the night of the release (June 5) You don't need to do anything to receive these updates.

## What's New in MediaManager 5.6.1

### Bug Fixes:

#### **Corrected a data corruption issue in MinutesMaker**

We've corrected a data corruption issue regarding data missing from minutes produced in MinutesMaker. MinutesMaker is now importing all notes to a new minutes document and all data in the agenda displays properly in MinutesMaker.

#### **Corrected an issue with the embed feature for the new video player for H264/HTML5**

When using the new video player for H264/HTML5, the embed feature lacked the ability to mark start/stop points and select whether or not the video should auto-start due to missing embed functionality in JWPlayer-based players. This issue has been resolved and the new video player for H264/HTML5 is working properly.

## What's New in Legistar 5.2.125.1506

### Feature:

#### **Current Approver's Line is now highlighted in the ATS sequence.**

We've added a feature that highlights the person who is currently in control of an ATS sequence. The entry for that person in the ATS grid is **bold** and **green**.

**Bug Fixes:**

**Introduced a check box on the Actions tab in Minutes called *Failed Without Second* to correct an inconsistency between Legistar and MediaManager**

The result of a vote is recorded when a member moves to make a motion on an agenda item in LiveManager. If a motion is not seconded by any other member, the motion fails for a lack of a second. Previously, this result was recorded in LiveManager. However, Legistar didn't have a corresponding field in the minutes history. We've added a check box below the Secunder drop-down on the Actions page in Legistar to correctly capture the vote.

**Corrected an issue in Legistar to ensure the file number stays the same when switching between the Minutes and Action tab**

When switching between the Minutes and Actions tab the file number switched to the top of the list of files. We've corrected an issue in Legistar to ensure the file number stays the same when switching between the Minutes and Actions tab.

**Fixed an issue regarding votes not displaying when navigating from a file's History due to springsys changes**

Due to springsys changes, a blank screen instead of votes were displaying when you navigated from the History tab. Now when you navigate from the file's History tab, you are taken to the Minutes/Votes section.

**Corrected an issue to ensure that all drop-downs stay on the Actions subtab when the screen is minimized**

The Motion Text area remained large, but the Secunder disappeared from the view when you opened any minutes and selected and minimized the Actions subtab. Now, all drop-downs are visible at all times.

## InSite 5.2.125.1506

**Story:**

**Improved the speed of the GranicusFileConverter in Legistar**

We've improved the speed and reliability of the PDF conversion service in Legistar.

**Bug Fixes:**

**Corrected an issue to prevent video URLs from being deleted if a URL is added via InSite and edited in Legistar**

When you added a video URL via InSite it was deleted automatically if any changes were made to the meeting in Legistar. This issue has been resolved. Now, you can insert URL strings into the Media field in Legistar for a meeting rather than doing it in InSite.

**Body Name appeared as a link on the Legislation Details page in InSite when the Show On Web box was not checked in Legistar Admin**

In Legistar Admin, when the **Show On Web** box was unchecked the Body Name still showed as a link on the Legislation Details page in InSite. Now, the Body Name only appears as a link on the Legislation Details page if you check the

**Show On Web** box in Legistar Admin. By default the **Show on Web** box is unchecked.

#### **Corrected an issue with the GranicusFileConverter**

Occasionally, the GranicusFileConverter would crash when it encountered a situation where the output file could not be deleted, thereby halting all further PDF conversions. This could be from multiple sources, but it frequently appeared to be a stalled epdmsvr.exe process from a previous run.

#### **Text files retain formatting each time an approver edits the text in ATS**

ATS files were losing formatting the second time an approver edited the text file in ATS Web. We have corrected this issue and the formatting displays properly.

#### **Alerts about legislation are being delivered properly from Insite**

Email alerts were not being delivered about legislation from Insite. We have resolved this issue and alerts are now being received from InSite

## **SpeakUp**

#### **Bug Fix:**

#### **Corrected a timestamp discrepancy between the comments in SpeakUp and Discussions PDF report**

The Discussions timestamp in the Admin/Results view of SpeakUp was displaying a different time than the Discussions PDF report. The timestamp now displays the same and correct time in both SpeakUp and in the PDF report.

## **MeetingServer/LiveManager 3.6.23**

#### **Added an option, AAC Audio, to Granicus LiveManager Configuration application that allows you to turn off audio transcoding to AAC**

We've added an option to Granicus LiveManager Configuration application that allows you to turn off **audio transcoding to AAC**. By default **AAC Audio** is turned **On**.

#### **Modified MeetingServer to correct issue that caused text to become truncated when LiveManager was being used to timestamp an event**

Text was being truncated when LiveManager was being used to timestamp an event. MeetingServer has been modified to correct truncation of current agenda item text during a live event broadcast.
