

What's New in Granicus: June 26, 2015

These release notes are for the June 26, 2015 maintenance releases for MediaManager, Legistar, InSite and Boards and Commissions.

There are no products related to this release that require a client install. MediaManager, Legistar, InSight and Boards and Commissions are all SaaS upgrades and require no action on the user's end.

Hosted Updates

Hosted services are automatically updated on the night of the release (June 26th.) You don't need to do anything to receive these updates.

What's New in MediaManager 5.6.2

Bug Fix:

Corrected an issue with Minutes that prevented changing a person to a Mover in Edit Motion

After you logged into LiveManager and selected the **Minutes** tab, you were unable to move a person to the Mover position. This caused an import issue in Legistar. We've corrected the issue with Minutes that prevented changing a person to a Mover in Edit Motion. Data is now populating correctly in Legistar from MediaManager.

What's New in Legistar 5.2.125.1506.1

Bug Fix:

Corrected an issue that caused the Short Title from being pulled into Agenda Report after it was copied and edited using Microsoft Word for Texteditor in Admin

We've corrected an issue that prevented the Short Title from updating in the Agenda Report when you copied and edited a Text file with the **Use Microsoft Word For TextEditor** set to **Yes** in System Settings. The file description did not display the updated title in the agenda grid. Now, when you copy and edit a file the changes appear on the Text File of Title and the Title field.

InSite 5.2.125.1506 .1

Bug Fix:

Fixed an ATS issue in InSite that allowed anyone with the link to approve or disapprove files

Approval Tacking Emails were sent containing a link to approve a file that was visible to anyone who logged into InSite. They could click on the link and approve or disapprove the file. Now, the ATS emails contain links that are only visible to the person authorized to approve or disapprove and file.

Boards and Commissions

Bug Fix:

Board member's name appeared blank on the Roster page after editing application details

After editing a board member's application details, their name was showing up blank in the Board Roster. However, their name was still listed in the application. Now, when you edit a board member's application their name appears correctly on the Roster page.
