System-wide reports now live on the new Documents page

We have moved the existing system-wide reports (Vacancy Report, Boards Report, Master Roster Report, All Vacancies Report, Demographics Report) to the new Documents page. Clicking the **download cloud** icon, where you used to generate reports, now gives you a link to the new Documents page as well as the old Reports page to view reports generated prior to this release. Bug Fixes

Performance: Local Settings takes a long time to launch

We have significantly reduced the time it takes to launch Local Settings.

Users getting error message upon deletion of approver from original sequence

When setting up a new approver in ATS, you can no longer move away from the new line until the approver and email template have been selected. This will prevent the errors that occurred when trying to start a sequence or delete lines.

Admin: Error copying a body type's workflow in Work Flow Control

You can now copy a body type's workflow successfully.

Attempting to pause an already-paused ATS sequence should result in an error message

If a user pauses a sequence and then another user tries to pause it without refreshing the file in view, Legistar displays the following message: "Cannot pause a sequence that is either already in process or completed." The system then refreshes the view to show the actual status of the file.

"Operation failed with no details found" error message clarified

We have corrected an error message that appeared intermittently ("Operation failed with no details found") by replacing it with a message specific to what is actually failing in the application.

InSite: Text file changes are not applied from InSite ATS

Users can now make changes to the Word document without submitting an action for files in ATS in InSite.

What's New in Peak Agenda Management

New Feature

Peak Meeting Details Description Field Available on Agenda Reports

Bug Fixes

Updates to agenda item (additional attachment, title change) not reflected on agenda report

If the Admin or Agenda Coordinator has turned on custom numbering (or turned it on and subsequently turned it off), modifications to individual agenda items on the agenda are now properly reflected on the agenda and its subsequently generated reports and packets.

Changing the cover page include/exclude flag on an item does not immediately update data

If the cover page include/exclude flag is changed on an agenda item, an agenda packet that is created for the agenda containing that item immediately reflects the new setting of the cover page for that item.

Removing an agenda item from a section clears the selected meeting body from the item

When you remove an agenda item from an agenda section using the **x** icon on the agenda item card, the meeting body is now maintained on the details of that agenda item. This enables the item's drafter to find the item—by searching via meeting body—in order to place it on a different agenda.

Removing an agenda section containing items does not clear the meeting date from the items

If a section that had items assigned to it is removed from an agenda, these items now become unscheduled for the meeting body and are available to be added to another agenda.

What's New in SpeakUp

New Feature

Configuration settings: more than one email address allowed in notifications fields

This feature enables administrators to list more than one recipient for notifications by navigating to the SpeakUp Admin page, opening the Settings page, and selecting the Notifications tab. On the Notifications page, there are many email fields to which you can add recipients. You can now add multiple recipients to a field by separating each email address with a comma.

New Feature

Forgot Password link

Using the link on the home screen, you can now create a new password in the event you have forgotten yours.

Bug Fixes

Users unable to change view from the meeting page

You can now change between Agendas, Notes, and Bookmarks views from a meeting page as intended.

Second button should gray out after a motion has been seconded

It is now more evident in the user interface when a user has motioned or seconded an item. The **Motion** and **Second** buttons become unavailable (grayed out) to users after a different user on the same meeting has used those functions.

PDF conversion is cutting off margins from PowerPoint files
