December 2, 2016

New Feature

Download Peak-generated agenda packets as PDFs

You can now download Peak-generated agenda packets for meetings that have them. Note that the packet must have already been generated in Peak before it will be available for download in iLegislate.

October 7, 2016

Bug Fix

Attachment links from Legistar do not open as expected

Hyperlink attachments to agendas that were imported from Legistar now open as intended.

August 12, 2016

Bug Fixes

Meetings without associated encoder won't load

We have fixed an issue that prevented agendas not associated with an encoder or video source from loading. These types of agendas now load as intended.

Display of an attachment is limited to 10 pages

iLegislate for Windows and OS X now correctly displays all pages of PDF attachments; viewing is no longer limited to the first ten pages.

New Features

Column headers consistent between Agendas and Videos

Column headers in the **Videos** tab are now the same as the column headers in the **Agendas** tab.

Agenda annotation

You can now make highlights and annotations on PDF attachments to agenda items. Additionally, annotations made on PDF attachments to agenda items are saved per user. You can log in, return to the PDF, and view annotations created at a previous time.

New Features

New Refresh button

Upon initial release, there was no way to refresh the application. We've added a Refresh button, which enables you to load updates to the various pages of the application, including agendas, attachments, notes, and bookmarks.

Ability to open PDF attachments within the application

We have implemented a feature that enables you to view PDF attachments to agenda items within the application; you'll no longer need to save the attachment to your computer to open it. Select a PDF, and the file will open in a PDF viewer within the application. From the PDF viewer, you can save the attachment, adjust the size/width of the PDF, and navigate through the pages of the attachment with a page selector.

Active agenda item is now highlighted

When you've joined a live meeting and are viewing the agenda, the current item on the agenda will now be highlighted.

Introducing iLegislate for Windows and OSX

With this release, we are excited to announce the latest advancement for the iLegislate application: iLegislate for Windows and OSX. Just like the iOS and Android versions of the application, iLegislate for Windows and OSX enables elected officials and government staff to review meeting agendas, supporting documents, and archived video, and to bookmark items for easy retrieval. Notes and bookmarks are automatically backed up to the Granicus cloud when an internet connection is established.

When used in conjunction with Granicus's Citizen Engagement tool—eComment—and our VoteCast system, council members, commissioners, elected officials, and other stakeholders can review citizen feedback on important issues and record motions and votes from any Windows-based operating system device or on OSX.
